PROGRAM DETAILS

Arrival:

Individuals are dropped off (or take bus) and check in with CLNH staff at the Main St. Library (corner of Main and Thompson) between 9:30 and 10:00 a.m. As this program is created for individuals who can be independent with only one CLNH Support Worker for 6 individuals, parents/family members/advocates do not attend. Departure: Individuals are picked up (or take bus) by 2:00 pm.

Transportation available through Activan from Georgetown directly to Milton Arts Centre

Eligibility for program:

This program focuses on those who are capable of participating in activities in the community with a 1:6 ratio of staff to individuals (small group setting), can be in the community with minimal supervision and without parent/family/advocate presence, are not prompt dependent, have no significant behaviour or medical issues and are independent in toileting, eating, and other tasks. CLNH staff do not administer medication in this program.

Need for additional support:

If an individual needs additional support over and above the support provided by CLNH staff, the individual can still participate in the activities that are open to the public if they provide their own support worker. In such cases, the individual registers through the Town of Milton Recreation Dept. rather than through CLNH and the individual is not part of the CLNH program.

Fee for Service:

This program is eligible for payment through Passport funding.
